## Latest information prior to the congress

Dear colleagues,

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to Bordeaux very soon. Prior to the congress, we would like to provide you with some information about your stay.

## Arrival and orientation

You will find on the congress website details about the location of the congress venues as well as useful information for your arrival in Bordeaux, from the Saint-Jean train station or from the airport: <https://ciegl2022.sciencesconf.org/resource/page/id/35>

The "Pôle juridique et judiciaire" ("PJJ") is the Faculty of Law (with its name inscribed above the front door of the building). This is where you can pick up your conference badge as well as the programme and the items we are providing, including an urban transport ticket valid for the whole week.

Those who have not yet registered will be able to do so on Monday, as well as on Tuesday or Wednesday morning.

The congress will begin on Monday 29 August at 11 a.m. with an opening ceremony. Mr. Pierre Hurmic, the Mayor of Bordeaux, will welcome delegates. Afterwards, we will introduce the congress, presenting the rationale for its academic orientation and some reflections on epigraphy in Bordeaux, as well as providing other additional practical details about the organization of this CIEGL. We, therefore, hope that as many of you as possible will participate in the opening of the congress.

## Additional information on the congress venues

To gain access to the two congress buildings, we will ask you to wear your badge at all times. In addition, at the entrance of the "PJJ", the University of Bordeaux has asked us to carry out a bag check.

Each building is equipped with WIFI. (Details are given both on the paper programme).

A doctor will be present throughout the congress and will be able to intervene if anyone has a health problem.

Finally, while the government authorities have not given any instructions on wearing a mask, please be aware that the virus is still circulating in France. **We strongly recommend that you wear a mask** (surgical or rather
