

*Tituli Novi Graeci*

The field of epigraphy is kept in a constant state of rejuvenation thanks to new discoveries. New epigraphical texts from Western Europe to Central Asia not only add novel pieces of information but also allow epigraphists to revisit earlier documents that have been imperfectly comprehended. Participants in this panel will offer a first view to new *unpublished* inscriptions not previously presented in any other format. Any text written in Greek from the 8th century BCE to the 6th century CE is welcome; presentations of bilingual texts are also encouraged as long as the Greek component is substantial. Each presenter will be allotted 20 minutes, and each presentation will be followed by 10 minutes of discussion.

Each proposal must include the name of the proposer(s) and the indication 'Tituli Novi Graeci', and contain a summary of no more than 3000 characters (including spaces). The final selection will be determined by the head of the section in collaboration with the organizing committee. A response will be sent by September 2021.
