

TITULI NOVI LATINI

One of the most important features of the field of Greek and Latin epigraphy is that new discoveries each year continue to enrich our understanding of the Graeco-Roman world. This section of the congress will allow epigraphers to present new, previously unpublished Latin inscriptions for the first time to the scholarly community. Any text or texts written in Latin from the early Roman period to late Antiquity will be welcome. Bilingual texts, in which Latin forms the preponderant part, are also appropriate.

Each paper will last a maximum of 20 minutes, to be followed by 10 minutes of discussion. Papers may be given in one of the five languages of the congress (French, English, German, Italian or Spanish). Please send an abstract of your proposed paper of no more than 3000 characters (including spaces) by e-mail to the congress secretariat (Sonia Syllac, ciegl2022@sciencesconf.org) before **March 30, 2021**. Each proposal must include the indication “Tituli Novi Latini”, the title of the paper and the name of the proposer(s). The final selection of papers to form part of this panel will be determined by the panel organizers in collaboration with the organizing committee. A response will be sent to those who have submitted abstracts in September 2021.
